What is a business plan?



- A business plan is a written document that describes your business. It covers objectives, strategies, sales and financial forecast
- A business plan can be seen as a **map** to a potentially successful and sustainable business. This map will include **strategies**, **plans and schemes that will guide** the business to success.
- It is a road map that is used in order to keep the business in reaching its objectives.
- It is a detailed plan of action that sets out the nature and strategy of the business

• It includes information about the business's finances, and shows projections of how much money the business aims to make

The use of a business plan

A business plan can be used by entrepreneurs for a variety of objectives. It can be primarily used to get **funding** but there can be a number of uses and they are as follows:

- To create a complete strategy
- To raise money Bank finance
- Recruitment- to recruit top-level-employees
- To manage your business
- To help identify potential weaknesses
- Identifies and measure risks.

The purpose of a business plan

A business plan serves the following purposes:

- It is a reference guide for the owner
- Banks and individuals will not lend money or invest in a business without first analysing your business plans.
- It is a map to potential success
- It serves as promotion material for the business
- It encourages you to do thorough market research before starting the business.
- It helps to promote the business idea
- It assists in identifying possible difficulties and helps to create plans to combat them
- It allows you to see the end picture and to take into account all that is needed to accomplish the business goals.
